Prizes

Ribbons 1st – 6th for each trial. Ribbons and prizes for overall winners in each division (combining points earned in all trials). Gaited Division if 4+ entries in level.

Note: All classes will be run as Open classes unless there are sufficient entries to justify splitting into divisions. A class will be split into Open/Amateur/Youth divisions provided there will still be at least three or more entries in each of the split classes. In the case of a split, ribbons will be awarded to each of the split classes.

Option at Rated show for those NEW to the Sport: We offer riders the opportunity to participate in this event as "H/C". H/C Riders can have a coach, on foot, with them in the competition arena throughout their rides. The coach is available to assist both verbally (providing instructions/suggestions) and physically (assisting with the gate, etc.) to help ensure that both horse and rider have a positive experience with the sport. H/C riders are participating for schooling purposes only (hors concours); they are not competing for awards/points. ****Just note on entry form H/C with Level and pay that levels fee accordingly. No Non-member fee is required for H/C riders.

Rules The competition will use the United States Rules for Working Equitation Current Version. Please make sure your rules are up-to-date as Rules Change every December. They can be found on www.usawe.org go to the link for "Rules & Dressage Tests". PLEASE READ THE RULES TO AVOID CONFUSION ON MEMBERSHIPS AND LEVEL REQUIREMENTS!

All Horses entered into the B-Rated show must be registered with USAWE. Registration can be completed on www.usawe.org along with individual memberships.

Riders MUST be members of USAWE to earn points and awards in rated show. Non-member fee will be required if not a member as of the date of show.

*****Use of helmets is required for all competitors under 18 whenever they are mounted*****

Helmets are encouraged for EOH and Speed events.

Stabling, Paddocks and Hauling in: Eight(8) Permanent stalls and Six (6) temporary stalls available (more temporary stalls can be made available) for \$40 a day (2 bags bedding provided). PADDOCKS are available for \$10/night (paddocks are 5 Strand Electrobraided fencing).

Bedding \$7/bag. Haul Ins for show and schooling are \$25 per day. Stabling will be open as of 8am Friday May 6, 2022.

I, the undersigned (Releasor), on my behalf and on the behalf of my heirs, assigns, and successors in interest, and on behalf of my minor child(ren), or those persons or individuals for whom I am responsible acknowledge and understand the following:

- The inherent risks involved in riding, driving, and working around horses, and those risks listed in Florida Statutes § 773.01(6) (2012)
- The entities described above, including Southeast Baroque Horse Shows LLC. and any sponsors, property owners, or additional insureds, and or equine professionals associated with the above described events (collectively described as "Sponsors") will not be held responsible for any injury, death, damage, or loss to or by animals or equipment, including without limitation equines, canines, carriages, equipment use, for the care, or use of the animals or equines. This includes, but is not limited to damage by fire, theft, animal, human and/or equipment collision, escape and acts of God.
- In consideration for the privilege of participating in activities related with the activities located on or related to the Sponsors' property, equipment, equines, or animals, the undersigned Releasors expressly agree to assume the risk for any and all injury, loss or damage and agree to release, hold harmless, and indemnify Sponsors, together with all their agents/employees from any and all claims of injury, loss, damage or death caused by, resulting from or in any way related to the inherent risks of equine activities.
- Releasors agree that all farrier, veterinarian and medical expenses, including emergency care treatment are the sole responsibility of the owner of the animals on behalf of whom such services are rendered.
- Releasors expressly covenant not to sue or make claim against Sponsors, their heirs, successors, assigns, agents, servants or employees for any injury, loss, damage or death caused by, resulting from, or in any way related to any of the inherent risks of equine activities.
- Should any individual provision of this release agreement be declared null, void and unenforceable, all other provisions shall be in full force and effect. In the event of any claim or litigation arising out of this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to attorney's fees and costs. This is a legally binding agreement and each party has the right to seek and obtain the opinion of separate counsel before executing this document.

USAWE Release, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnification Agreement

I AGREE, in consideration of my participation in this Competition, to the following:

By entering a USA Working Equitation (“USAWE”)-licensed competition (the “Competition”) and entering into this agreement, I agree to be bound by the Bylaws, rules and policies of USAWE, the USAWE Code of Conduct and Social Media Policy and the local rules of the Competition (collectively the “Rules”). I hereby accept as final the decision of the Competition officials on any question arising under or related to the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, USAWE, their officials, directors, officers, and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I warrant that I am eligible to enter and/or to participate under the Rules, and that every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I hereby grant to USAWE and the Competition all rights to use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or USAWE. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, copyright, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. I further agree to bind my principals, representatives, employees and agents to these same conditions for my entry and competition, and warrant that I have full rights to bind myself and those who act on my behalf to these conditions.

I hereby acknowledge that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition as a rider, owner, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (the “Harm”), and I specifically waive any and all rights or claims to liability for such Harm associated with or as a result of participation in the Competition for myself, my principles, representatives, employees, agents and dependents and family members who may otherwise have a right to claim damages, monetarily or otherwise, as a result of my participation.

I hereby release and indemnify USAWE and the Competition and agree to hold both harmless from any and all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition, including all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I hereby expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including without limitation Harm resulting from the negligence of USAWE, or the Competition. I understand that I am entitled and encouraged to wear protective equipment without penalty.

I hereby agree that, if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to USAWE, and this agreement hereby serves as a Release of Information thereto. I represent that I, or my child if the undersigned is acting on their behalf, have the requisite training and abilities to safely participate in this Competition.

If the undersigned is a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, the undersigned consents to the child’s participation and agrees to assume all of the obligations of this agreement on the child’s behalf. The undersigned further warrants that they have the legal capacity to assume all the obligations of this agreement on the child’s behalf and shall assume all liability therefore.
